

## Instructions on how to give permissions on the r.a.d.editor folder

Internet Information Services v5.x name of account: <b>ASPNET</b> user	
FAT32 file system	NTFS file system
No need to give permissions on the r.a.d.editor folder.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Right-click on the folder where you have installed r.a.d.editor and select <b>Properties</b>. By default, this folder should be named <u>r.a.d.editorX.X</u> and should be located in the C:\inetpub\wwwroot directory.</li> <li>2. Click on the <b>Security</b> tab. If you do not see the security tab, go to step 3. Otherwise, go to step 8.</li> <li>3. The <b>Security</b> tab is not visible because you have <i>Simple File Sharing</i> enabled. You will need to disable it before you continue. To disable it, open a <b>Windows Explorer</b>.</li> <li>4. On the <b>Tools</b> menu, click <b>Folder Options</b>, and then click the <b>View</b> tab.</li> <li>5. In the <b>Advanced Settings</b> section, clear the <i>Use simple file sharing (Recommended)</i> check box (at the bottom of the list).</li> <li>6. Click <b>OK</b>.</li> <li>7. Right-click on the folder where you have installed r.a.d.editor and select <b>Properties</b>. Click on the <b>Security</b> tab.</li> <li>8. Click on <b>Add</b> (to add a new user).</li> <li>9. Type <b>ASPNET</b> and click on <b>Check Names</b>. <b>ASPNET</b> should underline (if it doesn't then you don't have Microsoft's .NET framework installed).</li> <li>10. Click <b>OK</b>.</li> <li>11. Select the account you have just created (it should be named <b>aspnet_wp account</b>) and check the <b>Full Control</b> box to give it full permissions.</li> <li>12. Click <b>OK</b>.</li> </ol>
Internet Information Services v6.x name of account: <b>Network Service</b>	
FAT32 file system	NTFS file system
No need to setup permissions on the r.a.d.designer or r.a.d.editor folders.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The same as above but replace <b>ASPNET</b> with <b>Network Service</b>.</li> </ol>
