No need to give permissions on the r.a.d. <b>spell</b> folder.	<ol> <li>Right-click on the folder where you have installed r.a.d.spell and select Properties. By default, this folder should be named <u>r.a.d.spellX.X</u> and should be located in the C:\Inetpub\wwwroot directory.</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>Click on the Security tab. If you do not see the security tab, go to step 3. Otherwise, go to step 8.</li> </ol>
	3. The <b>Security</b> tab is not visible because you have <i>Simple File</i> <i>Sharing</i> enabled. You will need to disable it before you continue. To disable it, open a <b>Windows Explorer</b> .
	<ol> <li>On the Tools menu, click Folder Options, and then click the View tab.</li> </ol>
	5. In the <b>Advanced Settings</b> section, clear the <i>Use simple file sharing (Recommended)</i> check box (at the bottom of the list).
	6. Click <b>OK</b> .
	<ol> <li>Right-click on the folder where you have installed r.a.d.spell and select Properties. Click on the Security tab.</li> </ol>
	8. Click on <b>Add</b> (to add a new user).
	<ol> <li>Type ASPNET and click on Check Names. ASPNET should underline (if it doesn't then you don't have Microsoft's .NET framework installed).</li> </ol>
	10. Click <b>OK</b> .
	<ol> <li>Select the account you have just created (it should be named aspnet_wp account) and check the Full Control box to give it full permissions.</li> </ol>
	12. Click <b>OK</b> .
